This case was originally heard by the Special Magistrate on December 11, 2014; and an Order was entered giving the Respondent a compliance date of February 12, 2015. An Affidavit of Non-Compliance was filed by the Inspector after reinspection on February 13, 2015. An Affidavit of Compliance was filed by the Inspector after reinspection on March 16, 2015.

This property is presently in compliance.

**RECOMMENDATION:** The Special Magistrate issue an Order constituting a **fine** in the reduced amount of **\$413.79**, which represents the Administrative costs for processing the case. The property was out of compliance 31 days, from February 13, 2015, through and including March 15, 2015, at \$250.00 per day, which totals \$7,750.00. It is further recommended that the reduced amount be paid within 30 days or the fine will revert to the original amount of \$7,750.00 and be recorded as a lien.

14-53-CESM - DAVID AND VICTORIA SNYDER - On March 12, 2015, the Special Magistrate issued an Order reducing the accrued fine of \$4,750.00 to the Administrative Costs of \$376.09 providing these costs are paid within 30 days. It was further Ordered that if the reduced amount was not paid within 30 days, the fine would revert to the original amount of \$4,750.00 and be recorded as a lien. The Respondents paid the reduced amount within the time specified by the Special Magistrate and a Satisfaction of Fine will be executed by the Special Magistrate at this meeting.
